SPECIAL NOTICE: RESTRICTED TRAFFIC FLOW



PROJECT:

The City of Berkeley Contractor, Ray’s Electric, will be performing lime treatment on westbound (WB) Hearst between Le Conte and Euclid. Ray’s Electric will also be paving Hearst between Henry and Highland, as well as a portion of Oxford north of Hearst and Le Roy north of Hearst.

Construction in your immediate vicinity may not extend for this entire period. Planned work hours are 7:00 am – 6:00 pm, **with a possible earlier start on Friday, October 13th**. No work is contemplated outside these hours unless special conditions arise. Please be advised that dates are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS:

Traffic will be seriously impacted along these streets and intersecting cross streets. Please plan to use alternate routes.

If you require use of any of the affected streets, please be advised of the following traffic restrictions as listed below:

- For lime treatment work on westbound Hearst between Le Conte and Euclid, the road will be closed 24 hours a day for the duration of the work. Please follow detours.
- For asphalt grinding and paving operations, from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm, traffic flow will be allowed in the eastbound direction along Hearst. Westbound direction may be detoured. Please follow detours.
- Please drive cautiously into and through the work area and obey all signage and/or flaggers.

OTHER ADVISORIES:

- The Contractor will implement dust control measures, but please be advised that dust cannot be completely eliminated.
- Please be advised of uneven pavement conditions throughout these areas that will persist outside of working hours.
- Persons sensitive to petroleum products should be aware that asphalt will be used in this project.
- Park vehicle outside construction area and obey “No Parking” signs to avoid oil spray or other complications. Oil and asphalt used during construction is not easily removed from feet, shoes, floors, and rugs.
- Tie or keep pets inside to assure their safety and that of workers.
- Keep children away from work area.
- Access to driveways of affected properties will be subject to delays. Please plan accordingly.
- City of Berkeley Zero Waste has been notified and plans to continue with regularly scheduled pick-ups.
